people, learning new things, or trying something that I have not yet tried. The possibilities of sharing with others what


I have learned and the things that I have tried. The possibilities of making life long friendships. The possibilities of being

Capt. Pat Ehlers lives in Franklin, WI. Pat opened his fly shop, The Fly Fishers Inc. in 1988. He has been fishing for over forty years and fly-fishing for over thirty of those. Pat has guided throughout Wisconsin and the Great Lakes as well as in Montana and Alaska.

Pat is a licensed United States Coast Guard Captain. He has taught fly-fishing schools, fly-casting and fly tying classes around the country. He has also appeared as a speaker and instructor at shows and seminars throughout the U.S.

Pat has designed a line of fly rods developed for warmwater fly-fishing for Tim Rajeff owner of the Echo Fly Rod Co. of Vancouver, WA, the Pat Ehlers' Echo Edge 84 fly rod series. He also has designed a series of fly lines, The Bass/Muskie line for the Airflo Fly Line Co. of England. Pat is a contract /royalty fly tier and consultant for Rainy's Flies of Logan, UT. Pat is a Technical Consultant and Advisor to Simms Fishing Products of Bozeman, MT.
