## MEMBERSHIP MEAL INCREASE

Every November Finnies and the SJRVFF Club negotiate a new contract for the upcoming year and as suspected we are facing another increase in food and venue cost for 2026. Please don't misunderstand me, I am in no way blaming Finnies for the increase. If you've been to Ruth's Chris or McDonalds it's all the same, the cost you are paying for a good steak or a burger and fries is substantially more than several years ago. Last year, we chose to absorb the increase and take a loss to the tune of about \$2,100.00. We knew this was not sustainable, but we were hoping we might see a leveling out of prices. **Unfortunately, that did not happen, and the Board of Directors decided we need to increase the cost to our members so beginning with the January meeting, the meal cost will increase to \$25.00.** We hated to do this but obviously a club our size could not continue to take those losses. *We plan to revisit this again next year, but we will need your help in controlling this cost by doing the following:*

- **Please make your dinner reservation by the cut-off date** as outlined in the Loop and the reservation reminders. Our contract requires us to pay for a minimum of 25 meals, so it is important I report an accurate number to Finnies
- If you reserved and found out you can't make it AND didn't let the club know, we would like to ask that you voluntarily send in the \$25.00 meal/ venue cost.
- If you reserve and later find out you cannot make the meeting, please let me know ASAP. There have been several occasions when I was not able to accommodate a member's reservation request after the reservation cutoff date or on the day of the meeting, only to find out the person who reserved knew some time ago they could not make it. If you notify me before the cutoff date and/or I'm able to give your reservation to another member it relieves you of the obligation to pay.
- If you don't reserve and pay for dinner, please be respectful of the process, don't eat what you did not pay for.

Thank you in advance for understanding and although I will be discussing this in more detail at the December meeting, please do not hesitate to contact me should you have any questions.


- You can pay your dues by credit card through the web site. Click on the “Join SJRVFF” tab and down toward the bottom you will see where you can pay via PayPal.
